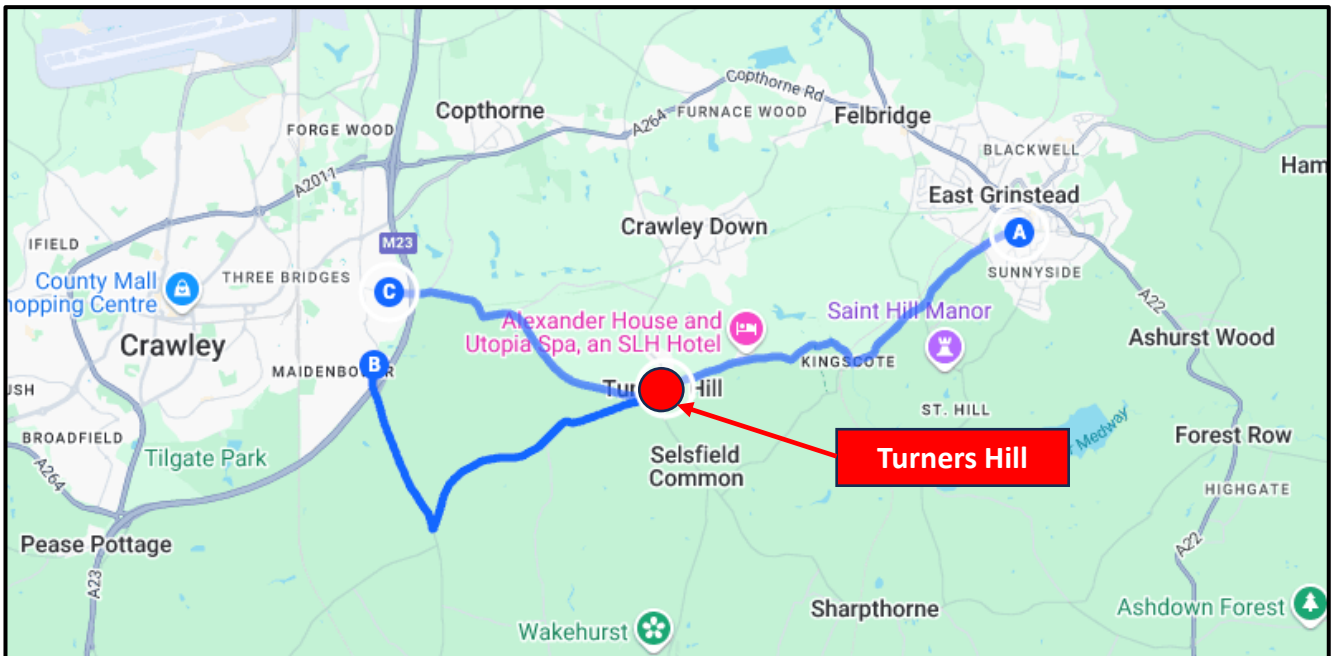


Gardeners Arms Access Plan

- This is a simple guide to maintain access to The Gardeners Arms Pub (RH17 6TJ) on Sunday 15th June.
- The 48th London to Brighton Bike ride is on, so the road outside The Gardeners Arms is officially closed to allow our 12,000 charity cyclists to head south to the sea.
- However, access from Turners Hill to the Pub is allowed for staff and guests. To avoid our cyclists, please see below some suggested access routes into Turners Hill.



- Route A to Turners Hill: If you are approaching from the East (East Grinstead direction) please use the B2110 into Turners Hill through Kingscote.
- Route B to Turners Hill: If you are approaching from the M23, please head Southwards on the B2036 then turn towards Turners Hill on the B2110
- Route C to Turners Hill: If you are approaching from the West (Crawley Direction) Please use The Turners Hill Road onto the B2110.

- Once at Turners Hill, please show our Stewards your Vehicle Access Pass and confirm you are heading to The Gardeners Arms.
- They will then direct you South on the B2028, Ardingly Road towards The Pub. Please note you will be driving on the Right-hand side of the road – this is the agreed traffic management plan with West Sussex Council.
- Once you arrive at The Gardeners Arms our stewards will park you in The Showground and support you in crossing our cyclist and any traffic.
